### **Choosing Your Options**

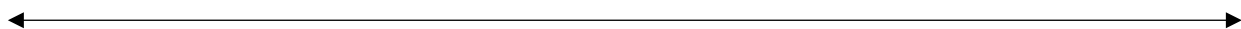
- Students entering Grade 9 will have a variety of optional courses to choose from.
