



Grade 7 Complimentary Courses (Options) 2025-2026

Dear Guardians and Students,

Welcome to St. John XXII Junior High! We are excited to be offering complimentary courses to expand students' studies. These classes offer students an opportunity to explore different courses, learn new skills and build new relationships with other students.

For the 2025-2026 school year, all English students in grade 7 are required to take French as a Second Language (FSL), while our French Immersion grade 7 students receive English Language Arts (ELA).

Students will be asked to rank their choices of complimentary courses, with the idea that the most popular choices will be the ones the school will offer. Thus, not all listed possibilities will be used as numbers will drive scheduling.

Students are asked to number their choices in order of preference from 1 to 6, with 1 being the **MOST** preferred choice (1=first choice), (2 = second choice) etc. and 6 being the **LEAST** preferred choice. Complimentary courses offered will be based on the top choices and time slots. While most courses will be half year, there are a couple that will be full year. Incomplete ranking will result in students being assigned to courses that are available by administration.
